

MBC In Person Worship Information Updated May 18, 2020

We are so excited to be having an In Person Worship Service on Sunday, May 24th. Here are some important guidelines for us to remember if you join us.

Sunday, May 24th

- Three Worship Service on Sunday Mornings for several weeks.
- Morning Service times will be: 8:00am - 9:30am - 11:00am.
 - All services will be the same.
 - Service in the FLC
- No Sunday Evening or Wednesday Evening services until August 1.
- No Nursery, Sunday School or Children/Youth activities until regulations relax more.
- On-line worship will be at 11am.
- Offering plates will not be passed, instead giving boxes will be available upon entrance and exit.
- No fellowship times during services
- Sanitation between services will occur
- Spacing in FLC will allow for a 6ft radius around every family unit in sections of 6 chairs spaced 6 ft apart. We can hold between 25-30 family units per service.

More Specific Details

- We will allow entrance at 10 minutes before the service your attending.
- Please enter through the awning and back parking lot main doors into FLC Hallway
- We will usher you to a seat and then lead you to the exits after the service is over.
- Exit will be through the Main Street end of the gym.
- The main building will be shut down.
- Touch Points will be at a minimum.
 - All furniture will be removed from the hallway of the FLC.
 - Doors will be opened by greeters only
- Bathrooms will be available for use. However, please remember to use your bathroom at home before the service. We have to sanitize the bathroom after every individual who enters.
- Sanitation between Services
 - Services will be approximately 45 minutes long.
 - Guests will be expected to leave immediately after service to allow the cleaning team to sanitize the building for the next service.
 - Hand sanitizer will be present throughout the FLC
 - The FLC will be sanitized between every service.
 - Services will begin exactly on time to keep schedule throughout the morning.
- Public Safety precautions
 - We encourage our most vulnerable church members to stay at home until regulations relax more.
 - We strongly encourage people to wear masks. We will also have some to hand out.
 - All volunteers will wear masks and gloves that we will provide if they don't have their own.
 - Please check your temperature at home. If it is over 100.0 degrees please stay home.
- Fluidity of these plans
 - These plans will be fluid and changing as the regulations dictate.
 - None of this is perfect and we will do everything we can to effectively worship and be healthy. Changes will occur often and even without much notice.
